#10 Good Magic – Dominant in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile, this Chad Brown-trained son of Curlin is just starting to get cranked up toward his spring campaign. The sky is the limit for him.

#1 Audible – Love the way this New York-bred attacked the ground in the recently run Holy Bull at Gulfstream for Todd Pletcher, who won last year's Kentucky Derby with Always Dreaming.

#9 Free Drop Billy – Second to Audible in the Holy Bull, this Dale Romans charge has the pedigree to run all day. He should continue to progress with added distance. The price is right.

#12 Mask – Visually impressive when winning the Mucho Macho Man by open lengths. He had a minor setback, which likely scare off some potential suitors. The risk is worth the reward.

#14 Mendelssohn – Euro wild card is tutored by all-world trainer Aidan O'Brien. Winner of the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf, he is a half-brother to dirt stars Beholder and Into Mischief.

#11 Instilled Regard – Million-dollar baby was bred to be a star. His Lecomte win at Fair Grounds was extremely professional, and his arrow is pointing way up. Deserves respect.
