



Thank you very much for your participation in Fair Grounds Race Course & Slots' first-ever Infield Festival to celebrate the 100<sup>th</sup> running of the Louisiana Derby. We look forward to having you join in the festivities on March 30!

To ensure that you are prepared with all the information you need in order to have a great festival time, please review the details contained within this letter.

If you purchased **VIP Suite & Observation Access** passes, your lanyard credentials grant you access to all food and beverage in the VIP Infield Suite, access to the observation deck and visibility to the Finish Line, as well as use of the executive restroom trailer facilities.

If you have purchased **VIP Tent Access** passes, your credentials include a wristband with four food/beverage tickets to be redeemed at any Food Truck, pop-up vendor or bar located on the Infield, as well as a VIP tent lanyard. Additionally, you will have access to the VIP Tent area just east of the Finish Line/Tote Board, as well as use of the executive restroom trailer facilities.

All VIP credentialed patrons will have special access to a VIP reserved concert viewing location next to the Jagermeister Stage. There will be televisions and United Tote betting machines in both the VIP Suite & VIP Tent.

All patrons purchasing Infield Festival General Admission passes will receive wristbands upon entering the Fair Grounds. These wristbands must be worn at all times.

While wearing your credentials (lanyard and/or wristband) you will be able to enter through any of the Fair Grounds' main entrances (East Turnstiles, Valet Lobby and West Turnstiles) while carrying collapsible chairs and/or festival baggage. You **MAY NOT** enter through the main Slots entrance facing Gentilly Boulevard with collapsible chairs and/or festival baggage. There will be signage throughout the property directing you to the Infield Festival crossover. The Infield Festival Crossover opens at 11a.m. The crossover pedestrian ramps will be open in between races allowing access to and from the Grandstand/Infield.

All festival-goers will walk across portable pedestrian ramps. Because there will be instances where you cross Infield grass and/or dirt we encourage you to wear appropriate shoes for such conditions. The Infield Festival attire is "resort casual" or general festival attire, as we anticipate warm weather.

Parking at Fair Grounds will be available on a first-come, first-served basis. Additional paid parking will be available at City Park in coordination with the Crescent City Classic. Once parked at City Park, a shuttle will be provided for ease of transportation to and from the Fair Grounds.
