## SPENCER'S SPOTLIGHT:

### RACE 7

#5 KALININGRAD was the 8-5 favorite when dropping in at this level last time out, and while he had to settle for second best behind an easy winner, he deserves another chance with this kind as he brings a pretty formidable looking set of drills into this. #2 SPICOLI woke up last out when dropped to this level, and he should get another good trip from close range. Price may not be much. #3 DATTTS OUR GUY woke up in a big way last time out on the barn change, and while I don't necessarily trust him to repeat that, he'd be a player if he did. #9 SHYSTERMEISTER had an impossibly wide trip in the debut, so I'm not really sure how good he is (or isn't), and #6 MIZZING FRAZIER gets blinkers off here, and that might be enough to give him a fighting chance for a piece.
