## Yesterday's Results: CBAABBBAAB

**Most Likely Winner: Race 6 -- #2 Cash Fever** – Has held his own with allowance company and now drops in for a similar price to what he was purchased for with a seemingly tactical, front end advantage.

**Best Bet: Race 5 -- #9 Imaboutago** – Wesley Ward is a wizard with turf sprinters and he hasn't run a horse the entire Fair Grounds meet. Ward does have a connection to jockey Jareth Loveberry through his agent Steve "The Architect" Leving, so chances are this first out winner is a live wire.

**Longshot: Race 3 -- #6 Crew Dragon** – This 6-year-old gelding ran some big races on turf earlier in his career, and a very slow break from the gate cost him a fair shot in his lone try here at Fair Grounds He ran huge off the grass sprinting two back but wilted in a two-turn sloppy track race last out. The signals are mixed but promising, and the price should be right.

**Favorite Against: Race 7 -- #1 Night Out** – I'm not really "against" any favorites today, including this guy, but since I picked him 3<sup>rd</sup> in the race, I guess he qualifies.
